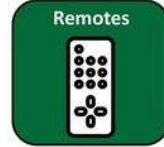

Community investment in the pandemic: Trends

- Demand - increase in requests
 - \$1 million Cameco COVID Relief Fund: 581 applications, \$17.5 million in requests
 - Immense competition for funding dollars
 - We supported 67 community projects across 40 different communities in SK

Community investment in the pandemic: Trends

- Demand - increase in requests
 - Cameco Step Up for Mental Health grant - \$384,000
 - Applications in fall 2020
 - We granted to 22 projects – but had double the number of applicants
